Tri-Set Sights Adjusting Screw Movements

If you want point of impact to come up turning the set screws down or in (clockwise) raises the rear sight. If you want to lower point of impact turn the set screws up or out (counter clockwise) which lowers the rear sight.

The slotted elevation screw works differently, turning the screw down (clockwise) lowers the rear sight. Turning it up (counter clockwise) raises the rear sight. Adjusting this screw affects all three set screws and should only be used for minimal adjustments, such as ammunition changes.

The three set screws when turned in or out by 1/4 turn will get you about 3 inches (76.2mm) at 25 yards (22.86 meters). The slotted elevation screw just behind the three set screws will get 1/4 inch (6.35mm) per click at 25 yards.
